What is it, who is behind and how to fight it

A blacklist (or black list) is a list or register of entities or people, for one reason or another, are being denied a particular privilege, service, mobility, access or recognition.

In 2009 a conspiracy against construction workers in the U.K. on a breath-taking scale was exposed. It was confirmed that major contractors including household names such as Balfour Beatty, Carillion, Laing O'Rourke, Sir Robert McAlpine and Skanska were systematically denying workers employment because of their association with trade unions, or of the 'crime' of fighting for safe working conditions.

It is a bleeding wound in the construction industry (and probably in many other industries) in the U.K.
