In this presentation, journalist *Kumru Başer* will explain the dramatic constitutional changes towards an absolute one-man rule, human rights violations of epic proportions, and the level of oppression that rendered the opposition totally ineffective, all happened within just one-and-a-half year under the Emergency Rule (OHAL).
