## State Crime the Rohingya Genocide in Myanmar





Since August 25th, 2017 last year, an estimated 22,000 Rohingya have been killed and 700,000 have been violently driven out of Myanmar by a joint military-BGP-Rakhine extremist campaign of murder, rape, sexual assault, arson, torture, terror, arbitrary arrest, and widespread destruction of property, and culture.

Penny Green will discuss in this talk genocide in the context of a state crime framework, and examine genocide as a process which in the case of Myanmar has been in the making for 30 years
